TREASURY, TREASURER'S TRUST AND LGIP FLOW CHART

The State Treasurer is charged with the cash management of public funds, which includes two categories of state funds and accounts: (1) funds and accounts located in the state treasury, which are subject to legislative appropriation; and (2) Treasurer's trust funds, which are accounts placed in the custody of the State Treasurer, and not typically subject to legislative appropriation. Funds within these accounts are commingled for investment and cash management purposes. This flow chart describes the structure of the Treasury and Treasurer's Trust Accounts. Month end balances of these accounts are shown on pages 4 and 5.

The State Constitution requires legislative appropriation to spend money from any of these accounts.



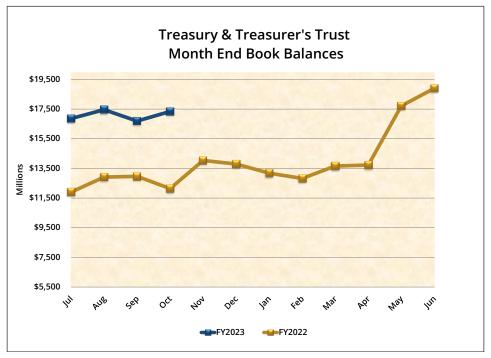
General Fund

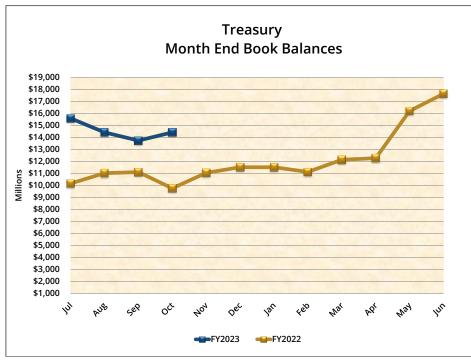
The General fund is one account from among hundreds in the Treasury. It is a main account used to pay for a large number of state services.

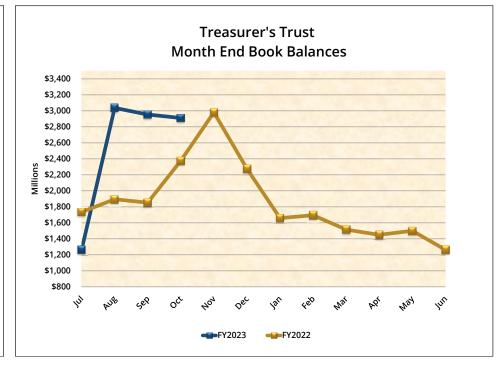
LGIP

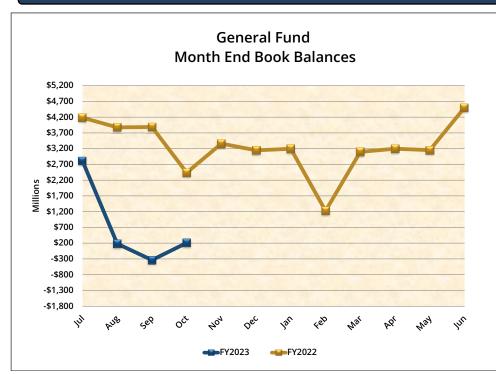
TREASURY & TREASURER'S TRUST AND TREASURY AND TREASURER'S TRUST CHART

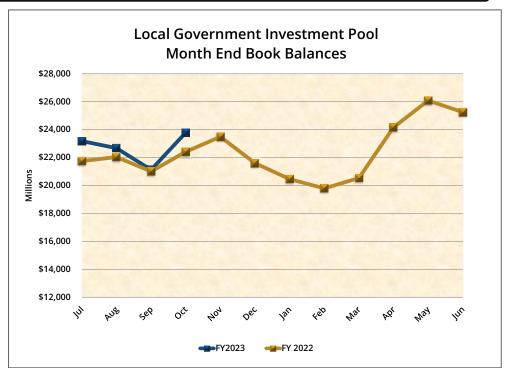


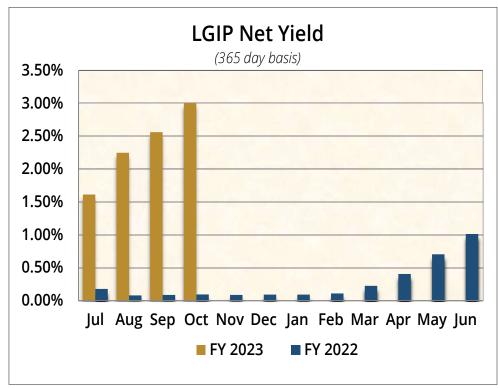




GENERAL FUND AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT INVESTMENT POOL CHARTS
