Olympia, Washington November 14, 2023 1:10 PM

The Washington Public Deposit Protection Commission met via Zoom, with an in-person viewing option for the public in Conference Room 1015 of the Helen Sommers Building in Olympia, in special meeting after notice duly given to the public.

Chair Pellicciotti called the Public Deposit Protection Commission (PDPC) meeting to order at 1:10 PM on November 14, 2023 and noted that all three PDPC members were present, and a quorum was established.

I. Commission Action – Approval of Minutes

Chair Pellicciotti asked for a motion to approve the March 22, 2023 PDPC meeting minutes, Lieutenant Governor Heck motioned approval, Governor Inslee seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

II. Commission Report – New PD Financial Institutions Update

Chair Pellicciotti introduced PDPC Administrator Mandy Kaplan, who provided an update on new public depositary changes approved since the last PDPC meeting. These included:

- Approval of Public Depositaries
 - Authority granted to America's Credit Union, Dupont Washington on April 20, 2023
 - Authority granted to OBEE Credit Union, Lacey, Washington on May 10, 2023
 - Authority granted to BMO Harris Bank N.A., Chicago, Illinois on June 20, 2023
 - Authority granted to Kitsap Credit Union, Bremerton, Washington on August 2, 2023
 - o Authority granted to Global Credit Union, Anchorage, Alaska on August 2, 2023
- Termination of Public Depositary
 - Termination of Seattle Credit Union, Seattle, Washington on October 6, 2023

II.	Public	Deposit	Protection	Commission	Overview	Update
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 Deputy Treasurer Shad Pruitt and Administrator Mandy Kaplan updated members on the public deposit protection program. They also reported that none of our public depositaries are operating under regulatory concern, all of our public depositaries met federal standards for being well capitalized, and all of our public depositaries are currently favorably rated.

Dear Chief Financial Officer Johnson:

We received your letter dated April 24, 2024, stating Seattle Bank (FDIC #35139) headquartered in Seattle, Washington, is requesting to terminate its status as a public depositary. Effective December 2, 2013, Seattle Bank was given the authority to accept public deposits in its Washington state branches under the terms of the Public Deposit Protection Act Chapters 39.58 Revised Code of Washington ("RCW") and 389-12 Washington Administrative Code ("WAC").

To withdraw as public depositary, financial institutions must report a zero balance of public funds on deposit the prior four commission reports (WAC 389-12-035). Seattle Bank has reported monthly public deposit balances of zero for the last four quarters and has verified a current zero balance of public funds on deposit.

Therefore, as of May 15, 2024, based upon authority delegated under Resolution No. 2018-3, I hereby approve your request to terminate Seattle Bank's public depositary status. Seattle Bank is no longer eligible to accept Washington public deposits.
